Watercolour Painting List of Materials Tutor: Deb Mawdsley

Watercolour Paints

Buy good quality, artist quality paints such as Winsor and Newton, Art Spectrum or Daniel Smith brands. Student quality are not as good, especially when mixing. You will need:

The primary colours:

- Cadmium red
- Cadmium yellow
- Ultramarine blue

Other colours:

- Alizarin crimson
- Yellow ochre
- Neutral tint or paynes grey

Watercolour paper- 300grm paper or heavier as these don't need to be stretched. These can be bought in loose sheets, pads or blocks.

- HB pencil
- Kneadable rubber
- Palette - with some small wells and a few larger areas for mixing colours.
- Brushes - a round soft hair or synthetic brush with a good point. About size 9 and a smaller brush for finer detail.

Tissues or toilet paper for mopping up paint.
